Camp of the Sixth South Carolina Regiment of Volunteers at Summerville S.C. on the tenth day of July 1861 to serve to the 11th of April 1862. he was born in Spartanburg District State of South Carolina is fifty-two years of age six feet high dark complexion dark eyes gray hair & by occupation when enlisted a farmer during the last two months said Soldier has been unfit for duty because of Dyspepsia & Rheumatism
